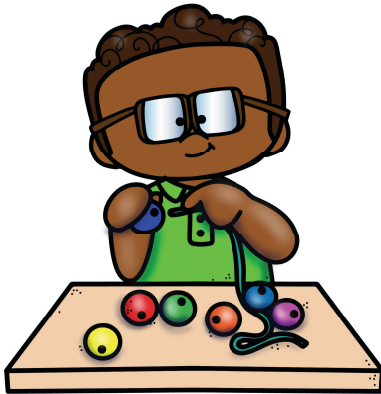
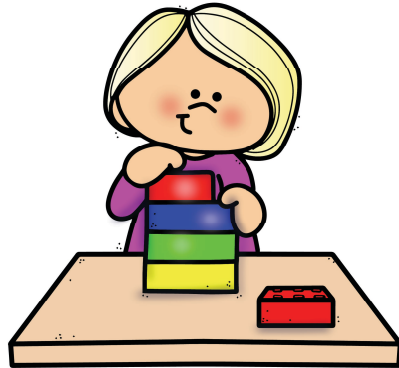
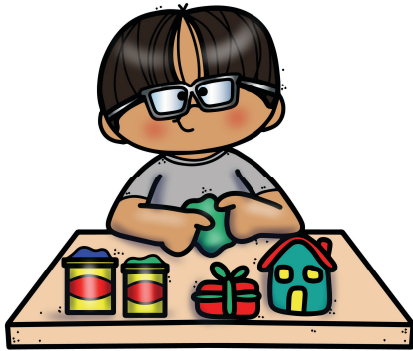


Some of those things are:

face shields and barriers.

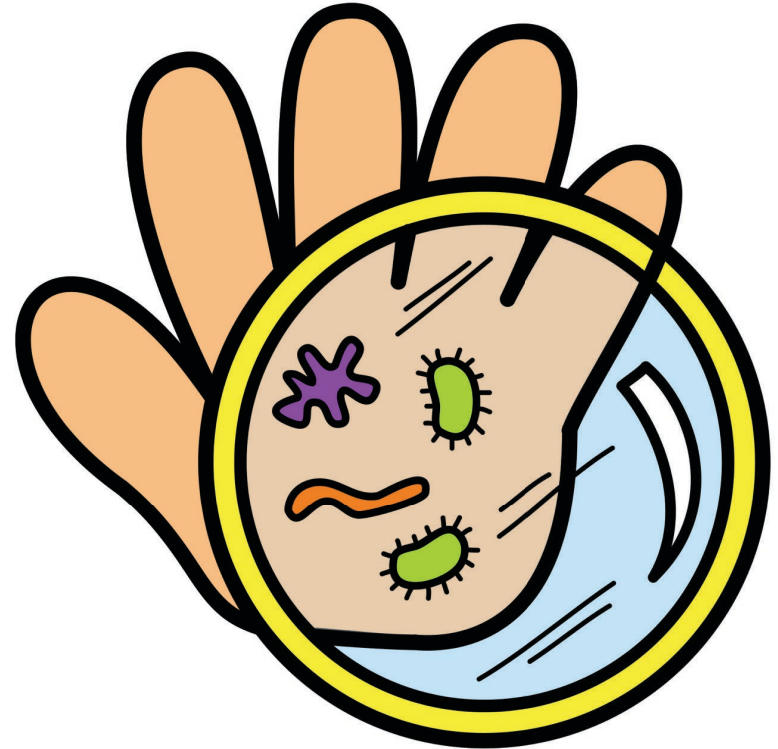

each student.



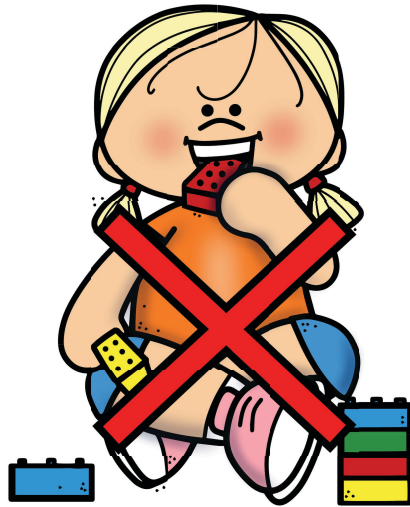
When a lot of people touch the
same things, it can spread germs.



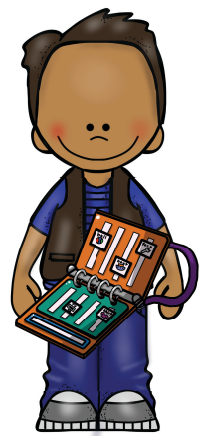
My teacher will tell me what the rules are in my classroom.



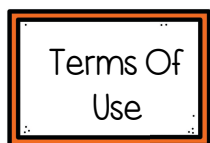
Playing with some toys might be a little different too. My teacher will tell me about that too.
